


# 1 Peter 1:13-2:3

#### **Salvation**

God is very different from people: we're so often mean and we often lie to get what we want. God is *always* pure and good and right. And He wants us to be like that too!

#### **Sanctification**

We deserve to be sent away from God forever because of all the wrong things we do, but God saves us from that punishment.

#### **Holy**

God's Holy Spirit changes us bit by bit to become more like Him!

God kindly gives us Jesus to be our **Saviour** and also our **King**. And He tells us in 1 Peter 1:13-2:3 to **remember** how Jesus saved us, and to **follow** Jesus as our King.
