

Who's coming at Christmas?

The Creator God! (John 1:1-5)

John tells us about someone very special called "The Word". In ancient Greece, people used to think that there was a thing called "The Word", which was a special power or idea that their gods used when they created the universe. But John tells us that "The Word" is with God, and "The Word" is God.

Why is it such good news that "The Word" came into the world? (*Look at verse 4 for clues, and tick all the right answers below!*)

Bringing **life** was such good news because the life Jesus offers is the *best* kind of life (see John 10:10) and it is life that lasts *forever* (see John 20:31)!

Bringing **light** was such good news because light always beats darkness! *Try it at home to see: go into a dark room and turn on the light. Can the darkness stop the light?*

John 1 verse 5 is a great memory verse to encourage us:

"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."
